- Black shoes and socks.

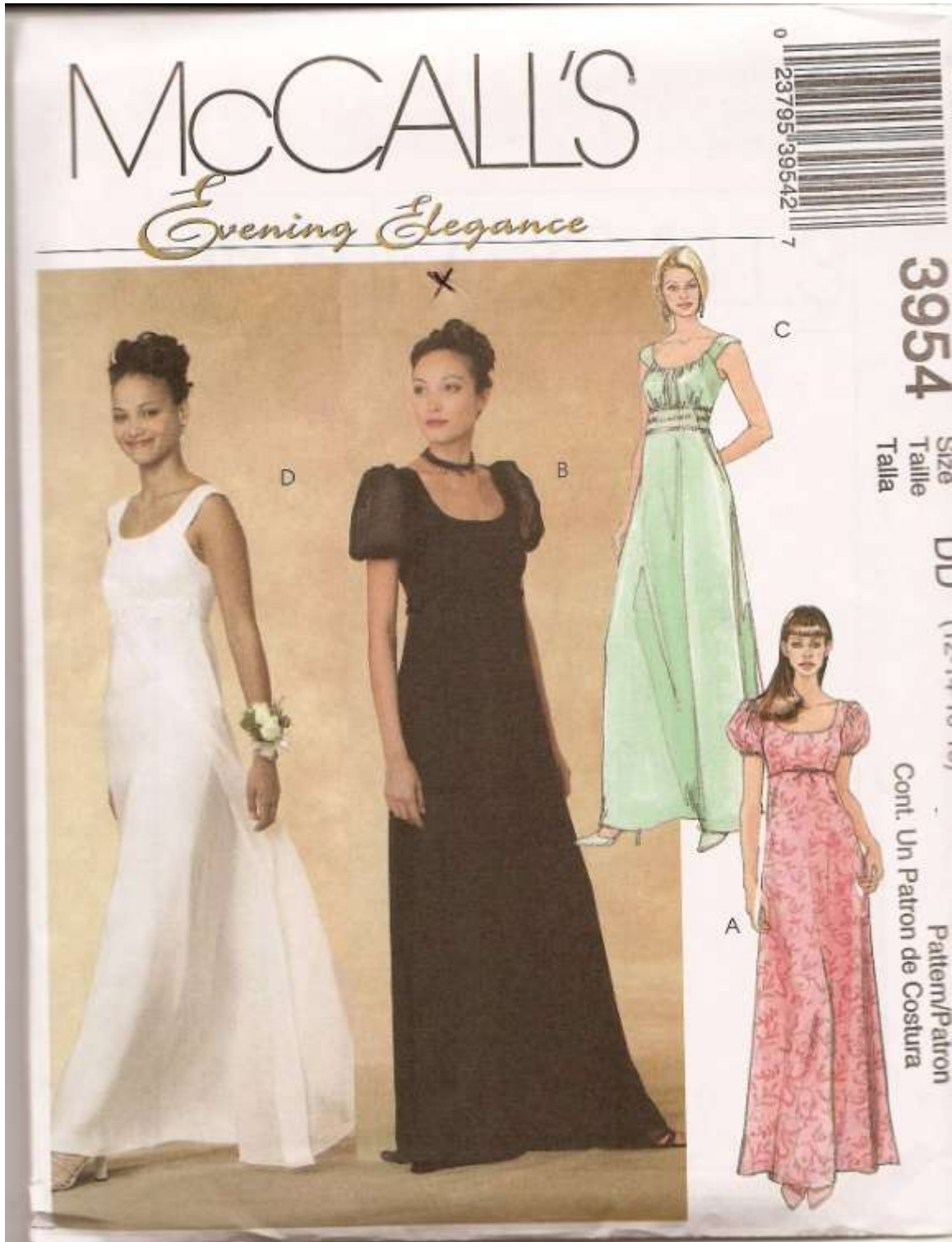
